Inquiries have been received from homeowners about the City of Carlsbad's Bulky Item Pick Up. Carlsbad residents may dispose of up to five bulky household items/three times annually at no charge. Residents must call <u>Waste Management</u> at 760-929-9400 at least 24 hours in advance of their regular collection day to schedule a pick-up.
