FIRST PHASE OF PAVING PROJECT COMPLETED

What's next? The second phase of the project will begin in July 2018 after the surface of the new asphalt "cures" for a few weeks. Black Diamond will return to Sealcoat and re-stripe the entire community. Sealcoat is a surface treatment that protects the surface of the asphalt and makes the community look great.

As we get closer to the second phase, homeowners and residents will receive a notice in the mail describing the phase plan with detailed project instructions.

Spring is just around the corner and it is the perfect time to get things in order around your home. Following are some spring tips:

- Now is a great time to clean out your garage.
- Look around the exterior of your home and see if there are any items that need fixing. Contact the management company to submit a work order if the item is maintained by the association.
- Report irrigation leaks to the management company along with any association landscaping maintenance items that need attention.
- Schedule a termite inspection for your home.
- Check your interior systems—HVAC-heating, ventilation, air conditioning systems to ensure they are in proper working condition, and replace air filters.
- Test your emergency systems in your home: home alarm, smoke fire alarm, fire extinguisher, and carbon monoxide alarms to ensure they are working properly.


