Disturbances, suspicious behavior, rule violations, etc., abound. As part of our service, we patrol the community at random times each night, monitoring the pool area and inspecting the streets for obvious parking violations, and check for suspicious activities and vehicles in common areas.

Residents may phone NCP to report **non-emergency** matters that may be occurring within the common area of the community. **You should dial 911 for any emergency or crime in progress before calling North Coast Patrol.**
